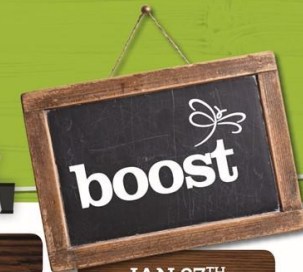
AFTER ACADEMY DAY – REVISION TIMETABLE FOR GCSE PREPARATION
