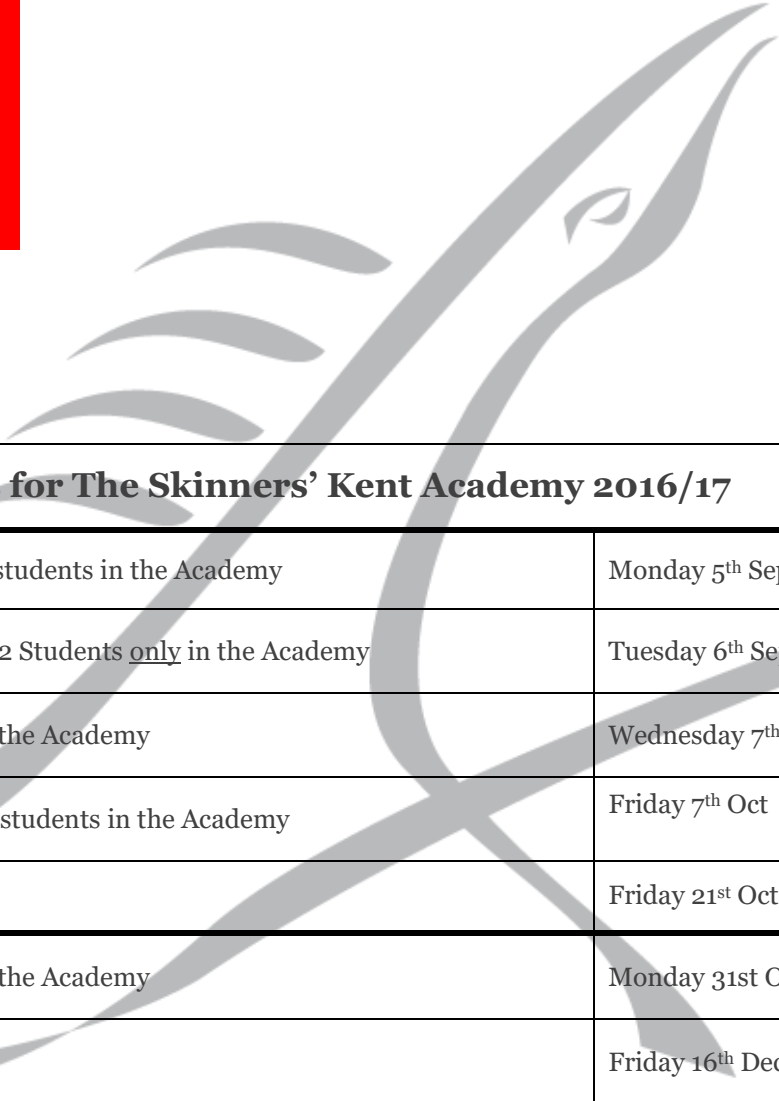
SAINSBURYS ACTIVE KIDS VOUCHERS
