IMPORTANT NOTICE SENT TO ALL TUNBRIDGE WELLS AND TONBRIDGE SCHOOLS BY THE LOCAL POLICING DISTRICT

"Tunbridge Wells Policing District have become more aware of young people frequenting derelict premises in the town.

Our primary concern will always be the welfare of the public. The students of several local schools have been identified as gaining access to empty town centre properties. We do not wish anyone hurt or killed because of unsafe structures, collapses etc.

Whilst we endeavour to ensure the private properties are secured, young people are adept at gaining access. Welfare issues aside, Tunbridge Wells Police are increasing patrols to local derelict properties and will deal with any persons found on site for criminal trespass and/or any offences disclosed.

We repeat, our primary concern is the health and welfare of students. We do not seek to criminalise; this e mail is a preventative effort so our patrols do not have to prosecute persons found in our sweeps.
