SCHOOL BUS (HAMS TRAVEL)

As many parents have become aware, Hams Travel are not permitted to accept a student who only carries Freedom Pass onto their buses. Whilst it has been at the discretion of the driver to allow students with a Freedom Pass onto their buses in the past, this is no longer the case. Freedom Passes are only permitted on regular service buses, i.e. Arriva. We would advise parents whose child carries a Freedom Pass and has been using Hams Travel (the route between Rusthall and the Academy) to seek alternative transport. 
