ROAD SAFETY ON AND AROUND THE ACADEMY SITE

We would remind parents that we do have a dedicated safe area in Blackhurst Lane car park for dropping off and picking up students at the start (07:30-08:30) and end (15:15-15:30) of the Academy day and would strongly urge you to use this space. Any drop off/pick up outside of these times should be done at the main Sandown Park entrance. Students should only be using the Sandown Park entrance if they use bicycles or scooters to travel to and from the Academy as this entrance enables students to access the cycle storage area, or the bus which drives directly onto our site. Student pedestrians should use the pedestrian entrance in Blackhurst Lane and enter the Academy through the Pen & Paper entrance.

We would specifically remind students that when leaving the Academy via the pedestrian exit in Blackhurst Lane, they **must** cross the road at the crossing point outside the Academy where staff are on duty. They must **not** walk to the traffic lights to cross at the main junction.

Please could we remind parents when dropping off/picking up students from the Sandown Park entrance outside of the above hours, due care is taken of access to our entrance, that it is kept clear of vehicles and is not used as a turning point. We do seek your support in this as we strive to ensure that we maintain a safe area around the Academy for both our own student community and that of our neighbours.
