As many parents have become aware, Hams Travel are not permitted to accept a student who only carries Freedom Pass onto their buses. Freedom Passes are only permitted on regular Service buses, i.e. Arriva. We would advise parents whose child carries a Freedom Pass and has been using Hams Travel (route from Rusthall to the Academy) to seek alternative public transport. 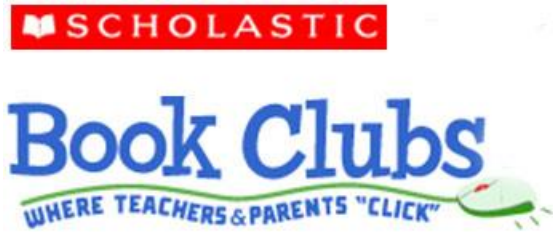
