MATHS WATCH

The Math's department at Skinners' Kent Academy continue to offer learning provisions through Math's Watch. Math's Watch is an interactive online support system and iPad application that gives students the opportunity to revise Math's by topic or grade through a series of videos and worksheets. The Academy's center ID is "skinnerskent" and each student has a unique login code that enables them to access the resource and track their progress. These should be known to the students but if not, they should ask their Math's teacher. There are 3 forms of Math's Watch: Math's Watch KS3 for Year 7 and Year 8 students, Math's Watch 2015 (new specification) for Year 9 and Year 10 and Math's Watch (old specification) for Year 11. Students should either download the appropriate Math's Watch application on their iPad from the App Store or access the website at www.mathswatch.vle.com to make the most of this differentiated resource.
